Senate Bill 684

Sponsored by Senator DEVLIN

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Permits Oregon Medical Board to issue limited license to practice medicine to physician licensed in another state or country who holds full-time professor appointment at school of medicine in this state.

Becomes operative January 1, 2016.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to limited license to practice medicine; creating new provisions; amending ORS 677.132; and 3 declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 4

SECTION 1. ORS 677.132 is amended to read: 5

677.132. (1)(a) When a need exists, the Oregon Medical Board may issue a limited license for a 6 7 specified period to an applicant who possesses the qualifications prescribed by the rules of the board. 8

9 (b) The board shall supervise the activities of the holder of a limited license and impose [such] 10 restrictions as [*it*] **the board** finds necessary.

(c) Each person holding a limited license under this subsection must obtain an unlimited li-11 cense at the earliest time possible. [After such time the] The board shall refuse to renew a limited 12 13 license issued under this subsection at the end of a [specified] period specified by rule if [it] the board determines that the holder [thereof] of the limited license is not pursuing diligently an at-14 tempt to become qualified for [a] an unlimited license. 15

[(2)] (d) The board by rule shall prescribe the types of and limitations upon licenses issued under 16 this [section] **subsection**. 17

(2)(a) The board may issue a limited license to practice medicine in this state to a phy-18 sician who is licensed to practice medicine in another state or country and who: 19

20 (A) Holds a degree of Doctor of Medicine or its equivalent;

21

(B) Is appointed as a full-time professor of medicine at a school of medicine in this state;

22(C) Is in good standing with the state or country from which the physician holds a license to practice medicine; 23

(D) Meets any requirements established by rule of the board; and 24

(E) Pays the license fee established by rule of the board. 25

26 (b) The board may establish by rule other criteria or qualifications that a physician ap-27 plying for the limited license described in this subsection must meet.

28 (c) A physician who is issued the limited license described in this subsection may practice 29 medicine only in conjunction with a full-time appointment as a professor of medicine. A limited license is valid only so long as the physician maintains the full-time appointment. 30

1 (3) A person licensed under this section is subject to all the provisions of this chapter and to 2 all the rules of the board[,] **and** has the same duties and responsibilities and is subject to the same 3 penalties and sanctions as any other person licensed under this chapter.

4 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) The amendments to ORS 677.132 by section 1 of this 2015 Act become 5 operative January 1, 2016.

6 (2) The Oregon Medical Board may take any action before the operative date specified in 7 subsection (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the board to exercise, on and after 8 the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of the duties, functions and 9 powers conferred on the board by the amendments to ORS 677.132 by section 1 of this 2015 10 Act.

11 <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 12 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect 13 on its passage.
