

Senate Bill 686

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON WORKFORCE

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Considers individual enrolled in alternative education program to be out-of-school youth for purposes of Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act.

2 Relating to eligibility under federal workforce development law.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 660.300 to**
5 **660.364.**

6 **SECTION 2. For the purposes of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014**
7 **(P.L. 113-128), an individual enrolled in an alternative education program as provided by ORS**
8 **336.615 to 336.675 is considered to be an out-of-school youth.**
