SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Health Authority for Senior Farm Direct Nutrition Program and Women, Infants and Children Farm Direct Nutrition Program.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Emergency Board for allocation to Oregon

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Emergency Board for allocation to Oregon Health Authority for matching funds for grant relating to provision of fresh fruits and vegetables, expansion of farm direct nutrition programs or other means of providing assistance for purchase of fresh fruits and vegetables.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$200,000, which may be expended for the purpose of providing assistance for the purchase of fresh, unprocessed, locally grown fruits, vegetables and herbs from farmers' markets or roadside stands under the Senior Farm Direct Nutrition Program.

- (2) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$100,000, which may be expended for the purpose of providing assistance for the purchase of fresh, unprocessed, locally grown fruits, vegetables and herbs from farmers' markets or roadside stands under the Women, Infants and Children Farm Direct Nutrition Program.
- SECTION 2. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$200,000, to be allocated to Oregon Health Authority for:
- (a) Matching funds for a grant from the United States Department of Agriculture through the federal WIC Farmers' Market Nutrition Program or the federal Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program or from any other federal or state agency, where the grant relates to the provision of fresh, unprocessed, locally grown fruits, vegetables and herbs;
- (b) Expansion of the Farm Direct Nutrition Program and the Senior Farm Direct Nutrition Program described in ORS 411.813; or

(c) Any other means of providing assistance for the purchase of fresh, unprocessed, lo-
cally grown fruits, vegetables and herbs.
(2) If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this section are not allocated
by the Emergency Board prior to December 1, 2016, the moneys remaining on that date be-
come available for any purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.

SECTION 3. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect July 1, 2015.
