

**SENATE AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 714**

1 On page 5 of the printed bill, delete lines 9 through 24 and insert:
2 “(17) Take any adverse action against a dealer for violating a prohibition that the manufacturer,
3 distributor or importer imposes on the dealer’s exporting a motor vehicle or selling a motor vehicle
4 for resale because the dealer sold a motor vehicle to a customer that exported or resold the motor
5 vehicle in violation of the prohibition, unless the manufacturer, distributor or importer provided the
6 dealer with written notice of the prohibition and the dealer knew or reasonably should have known
7 at the time the dealer sold the motor vehicle to the customer that the customer intended to export
8 or resell the vehicle in violation of the prohibition. A dealer that registers or causes a motor vehicle
9 to be registered in this state or another state and that collects or causes to be collected any sales
10 or use tax required in this state establishes a rebuttable presumption that the dealer did not have
11 reason to know that the customer intended to export or resell the motor vehicle.”.
