## B-Engrossed Senate Bill 72

Ordered by the Senate June 8 Including Senate Amendments dated March 6 and June 8

Sponsored by Senators MONNES ANDERSON, STEINER HAYWARD (Presession filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Increases fees to take nursing examination and renew nursing license.

Establishes Oregon Nursing Advancement Fund. Directs that moneys in fund be remitted to nonprofit organization that supports advancement of nursing profession in Oregon.

Limits biennial expenditures from Oregon Nursing Advancement Fund from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by Oregon State Board of Nursing. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to fees for nursing license; and declaring an emergency.

Whereas the advancement of the profession of nursing is important to the health of the residents

4 of this state; and

5 Whereas the Oregon Center for Nursing works to advance the profession of nursing in this state

6 through research, leadership development, educational support and advocacy for nursing; and

Whereas the center conducts research studies on the nursing workforce in this state, including
projected supply and demand of nurses and workforce shortages in nursing education and practice;
and

Whereas the center distributes information free of charge about the nursing workforce in this state to residents of this state; and

12 Whereas the center convenes nursing organizations to address issues and recommendations 13 identified through nursing workforce research; now, therefore,

14 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

15 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Oregon State Board of Nursing shall impose an additional \$9 fee for 16 each examination fee and each license renewal fee charged under ORS 678.410 for a regis-17 tered nurse or a licensed practical nurse for the purposes specified in subsection (2) of this 18 section.

(2) The additional fees imposed on examination fees and license renewals by subsection
(1) of this section shall be credited to the Oregon Nursing Advancement Fund established by
section 2 of this 2015 Act.

22 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) The Oregon Nursing Advancement Fund is established separate and dis-23 tinct from the General Fund. Interest earned by the Oregon Nursing Advancement Fund 24 shall be credited to the fund. Moneys in the fund are continuously appropriated to the 25 Oregon State Board of Nursing to be used as specified in subsection (2) of this section.

(2) The principal amount accrued in the fund shall be remitted once per year on a date 1 2 established by rule of the Oregon State Board of Nursing to an Oregon nonprofit organization that: 3 (a) Works to advance the profession of nursing in this state through research, leadership 4 development, educational support and advocacy for nursing; 5 (b) Conducts research studies on the nursing workforce in this state, including projected 6 supply and demand of nurses and workforce shortages in nursing education and practice; 7 (c) Distributes information free of charge about the nursing workforce in this state to 8 9 residents of this state; and (d) Convenes nursing organizations to address issues and recommendations identified 10 through nursing workforce research. 11 12SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$500,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of 13 expenses from the Oregon Nursing Advancement Fund from fees, moneys or other revenues, 14 15 including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or 16 received by the Oregon State Board of Nursing. SECTION 4. Section 1 of this 2015 Act applies to examinations administered and license 1718 renewals made on or after the effective date of this 2015 Act.

<u>SECTION 5.</u> This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect
 July 1, 2015.
