

Senate Bill 736

Sponsored by Senator SHIELDS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Human Services to submit report to interim legislative committees regarding status of juvenile mental health treatment in Oregon no later than July 1, 2016.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to juvenile mental health treatment; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) No later than July 1, 2016, the Department of Human Services shall**
5 **submit a report to the interim legislative committees on juveniles and health services re-**
6 **garding the status of juvenile mental health treatment in Oregon.**

7 **(2) The report may include recommendations for legislative changes.**

8 **(3) When preparing the report, the department shall consult with the Oregon Health**
9 **Authority.**

10 **SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
11 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**
12 **on its passage.**
