Senate Bill 767

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Human Services for domestic violence prevention, awareness and support programs.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to domestic violence programs; and declaring an emergency. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of 5 the General Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000, which may be expended for domestic violence 6 7 prevention, awareness and support programs. SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 8 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect 9 10 July 1, 2015. 11
