SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Provides that evidence of measures taken **or vulnerability assessments conducted** before natural disaster occurs that were intended to minimize impact of natural disaster is not admissible to prove negligence or culpable conduct in connection with natural disaster.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 40.010 to 40.585
5	SECTION 2. Evidence of measures taken or vulnerability assessments conducted before
6	a natural disaster occurs that were intended to minimize the impact of or plan for the na
7	tural disaster is not admissible to prove negligence or culpable conduct in connection with
8	damage, harm, injury or death resulting from the natural disaster.
9	SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2015 Act applies only to claims arising on or after the ef
10	fective date of this 2015 Act.
11	SECTION 4. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
12	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect
13	on its passage.
