CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to the State Department of Fish and Wildlife.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> The State Department of Fish and Wildlife shall conduct a study to determine whether ORS 497.006 should be amended to allow additional members of the uniformed services to be considered resident persons for the purpose of purchasing licenses, tags and permits issued by the State Fish and Wildlife Commission. The department shall submit a report with the results of the study, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to environment and natural resources in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 on or before September 15, 2016.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2015 Act is repealed on January 2, 2016.
