SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Oregon Health Authority to establish procedures to validate network capacity of coordinated care organizations.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. ORS 414.645 is amended to read:
5	414.645. (1) A coordinated care organization that contracts with the Oregon Health Authority
6	must maintain a network of providers sufficient in numbers and areas of practice and geographically
7	distributed in a manner to ensure that the health services provided under the contract are reason-
8	ably accessible to [enrollees] members.
9	(2) The authority shall actively monitor, and establish procedures to validate, the capac-
10	ity of a coordinated care organization to ensure that the requirements of subsection (1) of
11	this section are met.
12	[(2)] (3) [An enrollee] A member may transfer from one coordinated care organization to an-
13	other coordinated care organization no more than once during each enrollment period.
