## Senate Bill 808

Sponsored by Senator MONNES ANDERSON, Representative BOONE

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Directs Department of Human Services to coordinate and facilitate state and local community resilience planning to prepare for and respond to catastrophic consequences and mass displacement that may result from naturally occurring seismic events.

1 A BILL FOR AN ACT 2 Relating to seismic resilience planning. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 401. SECTION 2. (1) For each local government, as defined in ORS 174.116, the emergency 5 services agencies within the local government shall, in consultation with private organiza-6 7 tions related to providing emergency services within this state, develop and maintain a community resilience plan. 8 (2) The Department of Human Services shall coordinate and facilitate state and local 9 community resilience planning. The community resilience plan must address state and local 10 strategies and preparations to respond to the catastrophic consequences and mass displace-11 ment that may result from naturally occurring seismic events associated with geologic shift 12 along the Cascadia subduction zone, including providing, for the thousands of individuals and 13 14 entities likely to be affected: (a) Temporary shelter and permanent and semi-permanent housing; 15 (b) Emergency food and water supplies; 16 17 (c) Emergency health care services; and

(d) Transitional services and assistance with recovery.
