Senate Bill 811

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Education to create grant program to award grants to school districts and public charter schools to provide bonuses to educators who improve student outcomes.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to bonuses paid to educators who improve student outcomes.	
Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:	
SECTION 1. (1) In addition to those moneys distributed through	the State School Fund,
the Department of Education shall create a grant program to awar	d grants to school dis-
tricts and public charter schools to provide bonuses to educators wh	o improve student out-
comes.	
(2) The State Board of Education shall adopt by rule the criteria	by which:
(a) A school district or public charter school qualifies to receive	a grant under this sec-
tion and distributes the grant moneys to educators as bonuses.	
(b) The department determines the amount of a grant. The crite	ria shall take into con-
sideration the weighted average daily membership of the school dis	strict or public charter
school.	
(3) The department shall seek federal grant funds for the purpose	s of the grant program.
(4) For purposes of the grant program, the department may accep	t contributions of funds
and assistance from the United States Government and its agence	ies or from any other
source, public or private, and agree to conditions placed on the fund	ls not inconsistent with
the purposes of the grant program.
