

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 841

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 17 through 19 and insert:

2 “(4) If a drug is dispensed in less than a 30-day supply for the purpose of synchronizing a
3 patient’s prescription drug refills, a health plan shall:

4 “(a) Prorate the copayment; or

5 “(b) Adjust the copayment using a method approved by the Department of Consumer and Busi-
6 ness Services.”.

7 After line 26, insert:

8 “(7) The coverage required by this section may be limited by formulary restrictions applied to
9 a prescription drug by a health plan.

10 “(8)(a) This section does not apply to a prepaid group practice health plan with at least 200,000
11 enrollees in this state.

12 “(b) As used in this subsection, ‘prepaid group practice health plan’ means a health care service
13 contractor that provides physician services to its enrollees through an integrated health care de-
14 livery system using, primarily, a single group of physicians contracted on a prepaid, capitated
15 basis.”.

16 On page 2, line 7, after “after” delete the rest of the line and line 8 and insert “January 1,
17 2017.”.

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
