

Senate Bill 844

Sponsored by Senator BURDICK

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Specifies that premises licensed by Oregon Liquor Control Commission may receive marijuana items only from marijuana producer, marijuana processor or marijuana wholesaler operating as business at licensed premises.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to marijuana; amending section 27, chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2015.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** Section 27, chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2015, is amended to read:

5 **Sec. 27. (1)** A marijuana producer, marijuana processor[,] or marijuana wholesaler [*shall*] **may**
6 deliver marijuana items only to or on a licensed premises.

7 **(2) A licensed premises may receive marijuana items only from a marijuana producer,**
8 **marijuana processor or marijuana wholesaler for whom a premises has been licensed by the**
9 **Oregon Liquor Control Commission.**

10 **(3)** The sale of marijuana items [*under any license issued by the Oregon Liquor Control Com-*
11 *mission for retail sales by a licensee shall*] **by a marijuana retailer who holds a license issued**
12 **under section 22, chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2015, must** be restricted to the premises described in
13 the license, but deliveries may be made by the marijuana retailer to consumers pursuant to a bona
14 fide [*orders*] **order** received [*on*] **at** the licensed premises prior to delivery.
