## Senate Bill 852

Sponsored by Senator KNOPP

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Requires all information provided as part of candidate's statement for voters' pamphlet to be true.

Punishes violation by maximum of five years' imprisonment, \$125,000 fine, or both.

2	Relating to voters' pamphlet statements; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 251.085.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. ORS 251.085 is amended to read:
5	251.085. (1) The candidate's statement shall begin with a summary of the following: Occupation,
6	educational and occupational background, and prior governmental experience.
7	(2) All information provided as part of the candidate's statement must be true. Knowingly
8	providing false information within the candidate's statement is a violation of ORS 260.715 (1).
9	SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 251.085 by section 1 of this 2015 Act first apply to
10	candidate statements submitted on or after the effective date of this 2015 Act.
