

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 898

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, after the first semicolon delete the rest of the
2 line and line 3 and insert “and declaring an emergency.”.

3 Delete lines 5 through 27 and delete pages 2 through 5 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. (1) Except as provided by subsections (2) and (3) of this section, a school**
5 **district may not receive State School Fund distributions under ORS 327.013 for a student**
6 **who:**

7 **“(a) Has satisfied the requirements for a high school diploma, as provided by ORS 329.451**
8 **(2);**

9 **“(b) Remains enrolled at a school district; and**

10 **“(c) Has enrolled in one or more college-level courses offered through a community col-**
11 **lege or a public university listed in ORS 352.002.**

12 **“(2) Nothing in subsection (1) of this section prevents a school district from receiving**
13 **State School Fund distributions for a student who:**

14 **“(a) Has not been in grades 9 through 12 for more than a total of four years; or**

15 **“(b) Has been in grades 9 through 12 for more than a total of four years because the**
16 **student:**

17 **“(A) Has not satisfied the requirements for a high school diploma, as provided by ORS**
18 **329.451 (2);**

19 **“(B) Is satisfying the requirements for a modified diploma or an extended diploma; or**

20 **“(C) Has satisfied the requirements for a modified diploma or an extended diploma but**
21 **has not satisfied the requirements for a high school diploma, as provided by ORS 329.451 (2).**

22 **“(3) A school district may receive State School Fund distributions for a student described**
23 **in subsection (1) of this section if, prior to June 1, 2015, the student had enrolled in an edu-**
24 **cational program offered by the school district for the 2015-2016 school year.**

25 **“(4) Nothing in this section prohibits a school district from:**

26 **“(a) Expending moneys related to the education of students described in subsection (1)**
27 **of this section, as long as the school district does not receive State School Fund distributions**
28 **for that purpose; or**

29 **“(b) Entering into agreements with community colleges or public universities to provide**
30 **college-level courses to students of the school district and paying for the tuition, fees or**
31 **books for those courses with State School Fund distributions, as long as the courses are not**
32 **provided to students described in subsection (1) of this section.**

33 **“SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2015 Act applies to the 2015-2016 school year.**

34 **“SECTION 3. Section 1 of this 2015 Act is repealed on July 1, 2016.**

35 **“SECTION 4. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**

1 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**
2 **on its passage.”**
