

Senate Bill 903

Sponsored by Senator DEVLIN

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Repeals sunset of law authorizing only school districts to impose construction taxes.
Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to construction taxes imposed by a school district; repealing section 9, chapter 829, Oregon
3 Laws 2007; and prescribing an effective date.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. Section 9, chapter 829, Oregon Laws 2007, is repealed.**

6 **SECTION 2. This 2015 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2015**
7 **regular session of the Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
