## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Directs Oregon Military Department to submit report to interim legislative committees, no later than July 1, 2016, regarding implementation of Oregon Code of Military Justice. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT 2 Relating to the Oregon Military Department; and declaring an emergency. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. (1) No later than July 1, 2016, the Oregon Military Department shall submit 4 a report to the interim legislative committees on veterans' affairs and military affairs re-5 garding implementation of the Oregon Code of Military Justice in this state. 6 (2) The report shall include a summary of implementation barriers and may include rec-7 ommendations for legislative changes. 8 SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 9 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect 10 on its passage. 11
