Senate Bill 93

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires reimbursement for up to 60-day supply of prescription drug that is prescribed for chronic condition.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of the Insurance Code
5	SECTION 2. (1) A prescription drug benefit program, or a prescription drug benefit of
6	fered under a health benefit plan as defined in ORS 743.730, must provide for reimbursement
7	for up to a 60-day supply of a prescription drug dispensed by a pharmacy, as defined in ORS
8	689.005, if the prescription drug is covered by the program or plan and the prescription drug
9	is prescribed for a chronic condition.
10	(2) The State Board of Pharmacy shall adopt by rule a list of chronic conditions for which
11	a 60-day supply of a prescription drug must be reimbursed under this section.
12	(3) This section is exempt from ORS 743A.001.

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
