Senate Bill 95

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires facility dispensing Class 1 flammable liquids or diesel fuel to have manually-operated system capable of allowing liquid or fuel dispensing if usual electrical power supply to dispensing device is disrupted. Creates exception.

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 480.315 to 5 480.385.

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SECTION 2. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, any filling station, 6 service station, garage or other dispensary where Class 1 flammable liquid, except aviation 7 fuel, is dispensed or where diesel fuel is dispensed, including but not limited to nonretail fa-8 cilities, must have a manually-operated backup system capable of allowing the dispensing of 9 10 Class 1 flammable liquid or diesel fuel into fuel tanks or other containers if the usual electrical power supply to the dispensing devices is disrupted. 11 12 (2) A manually-operated backup system is not required under subsection (1) of this sec-13 tion for any dispensing device that has a backup electrical power system capable of operating

14 the dispensing device if the usual electrical power supply is disrupted.

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
