

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 950

1 After line 2 of the printed bill, insert:

2 “Whereas leading programs in architecture, wood science and engineering at the University of
3 Oregon and Oregon State University are collaborating to partner with building design professionals
4 and wood products manufacturers to drive innovation and testing for new engineered wood materials
5 at the Center for Advanced Wood Products Manufacturing and Design; and

6 “Whereas the research, product testing and educational programs conducted by the universities
7 at the center will foster innovative design of sustainable buildings and directly support growth of
8 manufacturing jobs in rural communities of this state where the timber industry is positioned to
9 capitalize on the growing demand for new products in domestic and global markets; now,
10 therefore,”

11 Delete lines 4 through 8 and insert:

12 “**SECTION 1. There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, from the Ad-**
13 **ministrative Services Economic Development Fund, to the Higher Education Coordinating**
14 **Commission, the amount of \$3,400,000 for use by the College of Forestry at Oregon State**
15 **University, in cooperation with the University of Oregon, to operate a center for the manu-**
16 **facturing and design of advanced wood products.”**
