

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 958

By COMMITTEE ON RURAL COMMUNITIES, LAND USE, AND WATER

1 Delete lines 4 through 9 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) An organizer of a fishing derby may apply for and obtain from the State**  
3 **Fish and Wildlife Commission a fishing derby license to take northern pikeminnow and to**  
4 **sell, for charitable fund-raising purposes, northern pikeminnow taken during the duration**  
5 **of the derby. A fee may not be charged for the license.**

6 **“(2) Upon receipt of an application for a fishing derby license, the commission shall re-**  
7 **view the application and issue a fishing derby license if the commission determines that the**  
8 **fishing derby will comply with the rules of the commission related to the protection of native**  
9 **fish species, including northern pikeminnow, and will be conducted in a manner that mini-**  
10 **mizes impacts on sensitive populations or habitats, except that the commission may issue**  
11 **no more than two fishing derby licenses per year for a given body of water.**

12 **“(3) A fishing derby for which a fishing derby license has been obtained under this section**  
13 **may have a duration of no longer than three days.**

14 **“(4) An organizer of a fishing derby is required to obtain a separate fishing derby license**  
15 **for each fishing derby.**

16 **“(5) The commission may adopt rules necessary to implement the provisions of this sec-**  
17 **tion. Notwithstanding ORS 508.025, 508.030, 508.035, 508.235, 508.260, 508.505 and 508.535, rules**  
18 **adopted by the commission may provide that separate licenses under the commercial fishing**  
19 **laws are not required for an organizer or a person to participate in a fishing derby for which**  
20 **the organizer holds a fishing derby license issued under this section.**

21 **“(6) This section is not intended to and may not be interpreted to exempt an organizer**  
22 **or a person participating in a fishing derby from any applicable licensing requirements under**  
23 **the wildlife laws.”.**
