Senate Joint Resolution 24

Sponsored by Senator FERRIOLI

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to limit awards of noneconomic damages in civil actions to \$1 million. Refers proposed amendment to people for their approval or rejection at next regular general

election.

JOINT RESOLUTION

2 Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:

3 **PARAGRAPH 1.** The Constitution of the State of Oregon is amended by creating a new section

4 12 to be added to and made a part of Article XV, such section to read:

5 SECTION 12. (1) Noneconomic damages may not be recovered in a civil action by or on 6 behalf of an injured person in an amount that exceeds \$1 million.

7 (2) For the purposes of this section, "noneconomic damages" means subjective, non-8 monetary losses, including but not limited to pain, mental suffering, emotional distress, hu-9 miliation, injury to reputation, loss of care, comfort, companionship and society, loss of 10 consortium, inconvenience, and interference with normal and usual activities apart from 11 gainful employment.
