

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 4

1 Delete lines 3 through 17 of the printed joint resolution and insert:

2 “**PARAGRAPH 1.** Section 1a, Article VII (Amended) of the Constitution of the State of Oregon,
3 is amended to read:

4 “**Sec. 1a.** *[Notwithstanding the provisions of section 1, Article VII (Amended) of this Constitution,*
5 *a judge of any court shall retire from judicial office at the end of the calendar year in which he attains*
6 *the age of 75 years.]* The Legislative Assembly or the people may by law:

7 “[*1*] *Fix a lesser age for mandatory retirement not earlier than the end of the calendar year in*
8 *which the judge attains the age of 70 years;]*

9 “[*2*] **(1)** Provide for recalling retired judges to temporary active service on the court from
10 which they are retired; and

11 “[*3*] **(2)** Authorize or require the retirement of judges for physical or mental disability or any
12 other cause rendering judges incapable of performing their judicial duties.

13 “[*This section shall not affect the term to which any judge shall have been elected or appointed*
14 *prior to or at the time of approval and ratification of this section.]”*
