1 On page 2 of the printed bill, after line 14, insert:

2 “(7) If the commissioner issues a temporary cease and desist order as described in subsection  
3 (6) of this section and the defendant prevails in a contested case hearing or upon appeal of a final  
4 order, the commissioner shall pay damages related to the commissioner’s enforcement of the tem-  
5 porary cease and desist order, including but not limited to actual damages and reasonable attorney  
6 fees incurred by the defendant and back pay to the defendant’s employees.”.
