

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2177**

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, after line 12, insert:

2 “(1)(a)(A) When a person who is at least 17 years of age applies for issu-
3 ance or renewal of an Oregon driver license, as defined in ORS 801.245, or
4 issuance of a state identification card under ORS 807.400 or submits a change
5 of address application form at a department office where driver license is-
6 suance or renewal applications, state identification card applications or
7 change of address applications are distributed or received, Department of
8 Transportation personnel shall inform the person that the person may regis-
9 ter to vote at the department office.

10 “(B) Department personnel shall ask the person whether the person is
11 registered to vote at the person’s current address and if not, whether the
12 person would like to register to vote at the department office.

13 “(C) Department personnel shall also inform the person that the legal
14 name, age, residence and citizenship information for, and the electronic sig-
15 nature of, the person will be treated as a voter registration card under ORS
16 247.002, if the person does not opt out of using the information for this pur-
17 pose.

18 “(b) The form for any Department of Transportation service listed under
19 paragraph (a) of this subsection must include a space for a person to indicate
20 that the person opts out of using the person’s information as a voter regis-
21 tration card.”.

22 In line 13, delete “(1)” and insert “(2)”.

1 In line 16, after “rule” insert “, and who has not opted out of using the
2 person’s information as a voter registration card under subsection (1)(b) of
3 this section”.

4 In line 17, delete “(2)” and insert “(3)”.

5 In line 18, delete “(1)” and insert “(2)”.

6 In line 20, delete the semicolon and delete lines 21 through 33 and insert
7 “adopt a political party affiliation.

8 “(4) If a person does not opt out of using the person’s information as a
9 voter registration card under subsection (1)(b) of this section, the person’s
10 electronic record and electronic signature submitted under subsection (2) of
11 this section will constitute a completed registration card for the person for
12 purposes of this chapter. The person shall be registered to vote if the county
13 clerk determines that the person is qualified to vote under Article II, section
14 2, of the Oregon Constitution, and the person is not already registered to
15 vote.”.

16 On page 6, line 4, delete “in the possession of” and insert “submitted
17 to”.
