PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 186

- On <u>page 1</u> of the printed bill, delete lines 15 and 16 and insert "an entity where allergens that are capable of causing a severe allergic response may be present.".
- In line 19, after "paraphernalia" delete the rest of the line and lines 20 through 23 and insert "in a locked, secure container that may be remotely unlocked and that is in close proximity to a communications device that allows a person to consult with a practitioner with prescriptive privileges.
- "(b) In an emergency situation, a practitioner with prescriptive privileges
 may authorize any person who consults with the practitioner using a communication device described in paragraph (a) of this subsection to possess
 and administer a premeasured dose of epinephrine to any person believed in
 good faith to be suffering a severe allergic response."
- On page 2, after line 18, insert:
- "(8) 'Practitioner with prescriptive privileges' means a practitioner authorized by law to administer or prescribe prescriptive drugs in this state or in the state in which the practitioner resides.".
- Delete line 19.
