

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 186**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 15 and 16 and insert “an entity  
2 where allergens that are capable of causing a severe allergic response may  
3 be present.”.

4 In line 19, after “paraphernalia” delete the rest of the line and lines 20  
5 through 23 and insert “in a locked, secure container that may be remotely  
6 unlocked and that is in close proximity to a communications device that al-  
7 lows a person to consult with a practitioner with prescriptive privileges.

8 “(b) In an emergency situation, a practitioner with prescriptive privileges  
9 may authorize any person who consults with the practitioner using a com-  
10 munication device described in paragraph (a) of this subsection to possess  
11 and administer a premeasured dose of epinephrine to any person believed in  
12 good faith to be suffering a severe allergic response.”.

13 On page 2, after line 18, insert:

14 “(8) ‘Practitioner with prescriptive privileges’ means a practitioner au-  
15 thorized by law to administer or prescribe prescriptive drugs in this state  
16 or in the state in which the practitioner resides.”.

17 Delete line 19.
