

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2177**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 3, delete “repealing ORS 802.085;”.

2 On page 2, after line 12, insert:

3 “(1)(a)(A) When a person who is at least 17 years of age applies for issu-
4 ance or renewal of an Oregon driver license, as defined in ORS 801.245, or
5 issuance of a state identification card under ORS 807.400 or submits a change
6 of address application form at a Department of Transportation office where
7 driver license issuance or renewal applications, state identification card ap-
8 plications or change of address applications are distributed or received, de-
9 partment personnel shall inform the person that the person may register to
10 vote at the department office.

11 “(B) Department personnel shall ask the person whether the person is
12 registered to vote at the person’s current address and, if not, whether the
13 person would like to register to vote at the department office.

14 “(C) Department personnel shall also inform the person that if the person
15 chooses to register to vote at the department office, the legal name, age,
16 residence and citizenship information for, and the electronic signature of, the
17 person will be treated as a voter registration card under ORS 247.002.

18 “(b) The form for any Department of Transportation service listed under
19 paragraph (a) of this subsection must include a space for a person to indicate
20 that the person chooses to permit the department to use the person’s infor-
21 mation as a voter registration card.”.

22 In line 13, delete “(1)” and insert “(2)”.

1 In line 16, after “rule” insert “and who has chosen to permit the depart-
2 ment to use the person’s information as a voter registration card under
3 subsection (1)(b) of this section”.

4 In line 17, delete “(2)” and insert “(3)”.

5 In line 18, delete “(1)” and insert “(2)”.

6 In line 20, delete the colon and insert “adopt a political party affiliation.

7 “(4) If a person chooses to permit the Department of Transportation to
8 use the person’s information as a voter registration card under subsection
9 (1)(b) of this section, the person’s electronic record and electronic signature
10 submitted under subsection (2) of this section will constitute a completed
11 registration card for the person for purposes of this chapter. The person shall
12 be registered to vote if the county clerk determines that the person is qual-
13 ified to vote under Article II, section 2, of the Oregon Constitution, and the
14 person is not already registered to vote.”.

15 Delete lines 21 through 33.

16 On page 6, line 4, delete “in the possession of” and insert “submitted
17 to”.

18 Delete line 9.

19 In line 10, delete “12” and insert “11”.
