PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2421

- On page 3 of the printed bill, line 2, delete "5" and insert "7".
- In line 7, delete "member's treating physician" and insert "prescriber".
- 3 In line 10, delete "2017" and insert "2018".
- 4 After line 10, insert:

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- "SECTION 3. (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall adopt the final rules implementing the amendments to ORS 414.325 by section 1 of this 2015 Act no later than May 1, 2016.
- "(2) The authority shall establish the amount of increase in global budgets of coordinated care organizations in order to accommodate the amendments to ORS 414.325 by section 1 of this 2015 Act no later than September 1, 2016.
- "SECTION 4. (1) The Task Force on Mental Health Drug Management is established, consisting of nine members appointed by the Director of the Oregon Health Authority as follows:
- 15 "(a) One representative of consumers of mental health care;
- 16 "(b) Two representatives of mental health treatment clinicians or 17 prescribers of mental health drugs;
- 18 "(c) One representative of the Oregon Health Authority;
- 19 "(d) One individual with expertise in mental health treatment pol-20 icy; and
 - "(e) Four representatives of coordinated care organizations.
 - "(2) The task force shall study and advise the authority on the im-

- plementation of the amendments to ORS 414.325 by section 1 of this
- 2 2015 Act and on corresponding changes to the global budgets of coor-
- 3 dinated care organizations in order to manage mental health drugs for
- 4 members.

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- 5 "(3) A majority of the voting members of the task force constitutes 6 a quorum for the transaction of business.
- "(4) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a majority of the voting members of the task force.
- 9 "(5) The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as 10 chairperson.
- 11 "(6) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the director shall make an 12 appointment to become immediately effective.
- "(7) The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the call of the chairperson or of a majority of the voting members of the task force.
- 16 "(8) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation of the task force.
- "(9)(a) The task force shall provide an update on its progress to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health, as appropriate, no later than September 15, 2015.
 - "(b) The task force shall provide an update on its progress to the Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly during the 2016 regular session.
 - "(10) The authority shall provide staff support to the task force.
- "(11) Members of the task force are not entitled to compensation, but may be reimbursed for actual and necessary travel and other expenses incurred by them in the performance of their official duties in the manner and amounts provided for in ORS 292.495. Claims for expenses shall be paid out of funds appropriated to the authority for purposes of the task force.
 - "(12) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111,

- are directed to assist the task force in the performance of its duties
- and, to the extent permitted by laws relating to confidentiality, to
- 3 furnish such information and advice as the members of the task force
- 4 consider necessary to perform their duties.".

- 8 "SECTION 7. (1) Section 2 of this 2015 Act and the amendments to

- "(2) The repeal of ORS 414.742 by section 6 of this 2015 Act becomes operative January 1, 2017.
- "(3) Sections 3 and 4 of this 2015 Act are repealed on December 31, 2016."
