PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2641

- Delete lines 6 through 27 of the printed bill and insert:
 - "SECTION 2. (1) Prior to awarding an animal, other than a fish, weighing 15 pounds or more as a prize in a contest, drawing, sweepstakes or lottery, a person shall:
- 5 "(a) Ensure that the animal is provided with at least minimum care 6 prior to the contest, drawing, sweepstakes or lottery; and
 - "(b) Obtain a signed statement from the potential recipient or, if the potential recipient is under 18 years of age, the potential recipient's parent or a legal guardian residing with the potential recipient, affirming that the potential recipient is aware that the potential recipient, or the parent or guardian of the potential recipient, could become legally responsible for providing minimum care for an animal.
 - "(2) A person commits the offense of unlawfully awarding an animal as a prize if the person knowingly transfers an animal, other than a fish, weighing 15 pounds or more to another person as a prize in a contest, drawing, sweepstakes or lottery in violation of subsection (1) of this section.
- 19 **"(3) Unlawfully awarding an animal as a prize is a Class D** 20 **violation.**".
