

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 472**

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, delete “section 2,” and insert “sections 2, 3  
2 and 4,”.

3 In line 3, after “2009” insert “; and declaring an emergency”.

4 After line 24, insert:

5 **“SECTION 2.** Section 3, chapter 823, Oregon Laws 2009, as amended by  
6 section 7, chapter 30, Oregon Laws 2010, is amended to read:

7 **“Sec. 3.** (1) After deduction of the cost of administration of the Pacific  
8 Wonderland registration plate program, the Department of Transportation  
9 shall transfer 50 percent of the moneys from the surcharge imposed by sec-  
10 tion 2, chapter 823, Oregon Laws 2009, to the Oregon State Capitol Founda-  
11 tion for the [*purpose of establishing and maintaining an Oregon History*  
12 *Center at the State Capitol or on the grounds of the State Capitol State*  
13 *Park*] **general purposes of the foundation under ORS 173.500** and 50  
14 percent to the Oregon Historical Society.

15 “(2) As used in this section, the cost of administration of the Pacific  
16 Wonderland registration plate program is the sum of all department expenses  
17 for the issuance or transfer of Pacific Wonderland registration plates under  
18 section 2, chapter 823, Oregon Laws 2009, that are above the normal costs  
19 of issuing, renewing and transferring registration plates in the normal course  
20 of the business of the department. These expenses include, but are not lim-  
21 ited to, the costs of collecting the Pacific Wonderland registration plate  
22 surcharge and transferring Pacific Wonderland registration plates.

1        **“SECTION 3.** Section 4, chapter 823, Oregon Laws 2009, as amended by  
2 section 8, chapter 30, Oregon Laws 2010, is amended to read:

3        **“Sec. 4.** (1) Notwithstanding ORS 184.642, the Department of Transpor-  
4 tation may pay an amount up to \$150,000 from the Department of Transpor-  
5 tation Operating Fund for expenses incurred in initiating the Pacific  
6 Wonderland registration plate program established in section 2, chapter 823,  
7 Oregon Laws 2009, including but not limited to registration plate design,  
8 computer programming and production setup. Any portion of the amount paid  
9 that is not used for initiating the Pacific Wonderland registration plate  
10 program shall be transferred to the account established under subsection (2)  
11 of this section.

12        “(2) Notwithstanding section 3, chapter 823, Oregon Laws 2009, after de-  
13 duction of the cost of administration of the Pacific Wonderland registration  
14 plate program, the department shall transfer the moneys from the surcharge  
15 imposed by section 2, chapter 823, Oregon Laws 2009, to an account in the  
16 Department of Transportation Operating Fund until sufficient funds have  
17 accumulated for the purpose described in subsection (3) of this section.

18        “(3) When the department determines that moneys in sufficient amount  
19 are available in the account established under subsection (2) of this section,  
20 the department shall reimburse the Department of Transportation Operating  
21 Fund, without interest, in an amount equal to the amount paid from the  
22 Department of Transportation Operating Fund for the costs of initiating the  
23 Pacific Wonderland registration plate program.

24        “(4) Any moneys remaining in the account established under subsection  
25 (2) of this section after deduction of the reimbursement required under sub-  
26 section (3) of this section shall be transferred to the Oregon State Capitol  
27 Foundation for the *[purpose of establishing and maintaining an Oregon His-*  
28 *tory Center at the State Capitol or on the grounds of the State Capitol State*  
29 *Park]* **general purposes of the foundation under ORS 173.500** and to the  
30 Oregon Historical Society. Of the moneys transferred under this subsection,

1 50 percent shall be transferred to the Oregon State Capitol Foundation and  
2 50 percent shall be transferred to the Oregon Historical Society.

3 **“SECTION 4. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate**  
4 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**  
5 **declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**
