

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 321**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “339.010” delete the rest of the  
2 line and insert “and 339.020; and”.

3 Delete lines 5 through 31 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1.** ORS 339.010 is amended to read:

5 “339.010. (1) Except as provided in ORS 339.030[:],

6 “[*1*] all children between the ages of [7] **6** and 18 years who have not  
7 completed the 12th grade are required to attend regularly a public full-time  
8 school during the entire school term.

9 “(2) All children five [*or six*] years of age who have been enrolled in a  
10 public school are required to attend regularly the public school while en-  
11 rolled in the public school.

12 **“(3) For the purpose of this section, a child is considered to be six**  
13 **years of age if the sixth birthday of the child occurred on or before**  
14 **September 1 immediately preceding the beginning of the current**  
15 **school term.**

16 **“SECTION 2.** ORS 339.020 is amended to read:

17 “339.020. (1) Except as provided in ORS 339.030[:],

18 “[*1*] every person having control of a child between the ages of [7] **6** and  
19 18 years who has not completed the 12th grade is required to send the child  
20 to, and maintain the child in, regular attendance at a public full-time school  
21 during the entire school term.

22 “(2) If a person has control of a child five [*or six*] years of age and has

1 enrolled the child in a public school, the person is required to send the child  
2 to, and maintain the child in, regular attendance at the public school while  
3 the child is enrolled in the public school.

4 **“(3) For the purpose of this section, a child is considered to be six**  
5 **years of age if the sixth birthday of the child occurred on or before**  
6 **September 1 immediately preceding the beginning of the current**  
7 **school term.**

8 **“SECTION 3. This 2015 Act takes effect on July 1, 2016.”.**
