

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3041**

1 Delete lines 5 through 21 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, ‘allowed nonprescription**
3 **sunscreen’ means sunscreen that may be purchased without a pre-**
4 **scription and that does not contain para-aminobenzoic acid.**

5 **“(2) Each school district shall allow the following during school**
6 **hours, at a school-sponsored activity or while under the supervision**
7 **of school personnel:**

8 **“(a) The outdoor use by students of sun-protective clothing, in-**
9 **cluding hats; and**

10 **“(b) The application of and use by students of allowed**
11 **nonprescription sunscreen.**

12 **“(3) For the purposes of subsection (2) of this section, each school**
13 **district board shall adopt policies related to:**

14 **“(a) The type of sun-protective clothing that may be used outdoors**
15 **by students in the schools of the school district. A policy adopted un-**
16 **der this paragraph may be adopted as part of the school district’s dress**
17 **code and may provide that the sun-protective clothing must comply**
18 **with other requirements of the school district’s dress code.**

19 **“(b) The application of and use by students of allowed**
20 **nonprescription sunscreen. A policy adopted under this paragraph:**

21 **“(A) May not require a student to provide any documentation from**
22 **a licensed health care professional; and**

1 **“(B) May allow school personnel to assist students in applying al-**
2 **lowed nonprescription sunscreen but may not require school personnel**
3 **to assist students in applying sunscreen.**

4 **“(4) School personnel may not be held liable in a criminal action**
5 **or for civil damages for application of allowed nonprescription**
6 **sunscreen or sunscreen that contains para-aminobenzoic acid if the**
7 **sunscreen is available to and used by the student in accordance with**
8 **policies adopted under this section.”.**
