PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 412

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after "waste" insert a period and delete the rest of the line.
- Delete lines 4 through 31 and delete pages 2 through 4 and insert:
- 4 "SECTION 1. (1) The Legislative Assembly finds and declares that:
- 5 "(a) Dredging by port districts in this state in furtherance of navi-6 gation and commercial development is essential to a strong and di-
- 7 verse economy;
- 8 "(b) Dredging is an activity regulated by both state and local authorities;
- 10 "(c) Dredged material can be a useful commercial product; and
- "(d) The movement, storage and use of dredged material is a beneficial activity that supports maritime commerce.
- 13 "(2) ORS 459.005 does not apply to material that:
- 14 "(a) Is dredged from submerged or submersible lands by a port dis-15 trict;
- 16 "(b) Is not commingled with other types of solid waste; and
- "(c)(A) Is placed upland in an area designated by the port district
 as a dredged material management area;
- 19 "(B) Is placed in water as part of the port's dredging operation;
- 20 "(C) Is sold as a commercial product; or
- 21 "(D) Is applied to a beneficial use, as defined by the Environmental 22 Quality Commission.

"(3) Consistent with the policy stated in subsection (1) of this sec-1 tion, the commission may adopt rules necessary for the protection of 2 human health or the environment concerning the management of dredged material subject to subsection (2) of this section.

"(4) As used in this section, 'port district' means any port formed pursuant to ORS 777.005 to 777.725 and 777.915 to 777.953 or ORS chapter
