PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2125

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after "care;" delete the rest of the
- 2 line and insert "creating new provisions; amending ORS 315.616 and section
- 3 25, chapter 913, Oregon Laws 2009; and prescribing an effective date.".
- 4 After line 12, insert:
- **"SECTION 2.** ORS 315.616 is amended to read:
- 6 "315.616. A resident or nonresident individual who is certified as eligible
- 7 under ORS 442.561, 442.562, 442.563 or 442.564, and is licensed as a physician
- 8 under ORS chapter 677, licensed as a physician assistant under ORS chapter
- 9 677, licensed as a nurse practitioner under ORS chapter 678, licensed as a
- 10 certified registered nurse anesthetist under ORS chapter 678, licensed as a
- dentist under ORS chapter 679 [or], licensed as an optometrist under ORS
- 683.010 to 683.340 or licensed as a pharmacist under ORS chapter 689 is
- entitled to the tax credit described in ORS 315.613 even if not a member of
- the hospital medical staff if the Office of Rural Health certifies that the in-
- 15 dividual:
- "(1) Is engaged for at least 20 hours per week, averaged over the month,
- during the tax year in a rural practice; and
- "(2)(a) If a physician or a physician assistant, can cause a patient to be
- 19 admitted to the hospital;
- 20 "(b) If a certified registered nurse anesthetist, is employed by or has a
- 21 contractual relationship with one of the hospitals described in ORS 315.613
- 22 (1); or

- "(c) If an optometrist, has consulting privileges with a hospital listed in ORS 315.613 (1). This paragraph does not apply to an optometrist who qualifies as a 'frontier rural practitioner,' as defined by the Office of Rural Health.
- "SECTION 3. The amendments to ORS 315.616 by section 2 of this
 2015 Act apply to tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2016.

"SECTION 4. This 2015 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2015 regular session of the Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.".
