

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2541**

1 Delete lines 8 through 23 of the printed bill and insert:

2 “(2) A person conducting a blood drive shall adopt policies and standard
3 operating procedures that set forth personnel qualifications, training re-
4 quirements, minimum staffing ratios and site policies to ensure:

5 “(a) Accuracy in donor eligibility screening; and

6 “(b) Safe response when donor complications arise at the blood drive.

7 “(3) At a minimum, the policies and procedures adopted under subsection
8 (2) of this section shall:

9 “(a) Include a medical contingency plan that describes the circumstances
10 under which a staff member shall notify 9-1-1 or other emergency care pro-
11 viders;

12 “(b) Require an on-site staff member to oversee all activities associated
13 with the collection of blood and blood components; and

14 “(c) Require that at least one on-site staff member be a health care prac-
15 titioner who is certified in cardiopulmonary resuscitation.

16 “(4) A person conducting a blood drive:

17 “(a) Shall develop a mandatory training program to train personnel on
18 activities involving the collection of blood and blood components; and

19 “(b) Is responsible for ensuring that personnel have met the training re-
20 quirements adopted under this section.”.

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
