

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2407**

1 On page 4 of the printed bill, after line 6, insert:

2 “(6)(a) The Executive Director of the Office of Student Access and Com-
3 pletion shall inform eligible post-secondary institutions of the identity of
4 qualified students who attend the institution and who receive a grant under
5 this section for more than one academic year.

6 “(b) To the extent possible, eligible post-secondary institutions shall en-
7 sure that qualified students identified under this subsection are made aware
8 of the academic guidance and counseling services available at the
9 institution.”.

10 In line 7, delete “(6)” and insert “(7)”.

11 In line 13, delete “(7)” and insert “(8)”.

12 After line 14, insert:

13 “(9)(a) The commission shall report annually on or before February 1 to
14 committees of the Legislative Assembly related to higher education regarding
15 the academic success and performance of qualified students who receive
16 grants under this section.

17 “(b) In order to meet the reporting requirements set forth in paragraph
18 (a) of this subsection:

19 “(A) The commission shall by rule design a method for evaluating the
20 academic success and performance of students who receive a grant under this
21 section; and

22 “(B) Upon a request from the commission, eligible post-secondary insti-

1 tutions must provide the commission with the data necessary for the com-
2 mission to conduct its analysis.”.

3 Delete lines 15 and 16 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 5. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section,**
5 **the amendments to ORS 348.205 and 348.260 by sections 1 and 4 of this**
6 **2015 Act first apply to Oregon Opportunity Grants awarded for the**
7 **2016-2017 academic year.**

8 **“(2) The first report to the committees of the Legislative Assembly**
9 **related to higher education required under ORS 348.260, as amended**
10 **by section 4 of this 2015 Act, must be filed by February 1, 2020.”.**

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
