

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3143**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 27 and delete page
2 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, ‘tax-exempt’ means re-**
4 **cognized as tax-exempt under section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue**
5 **Code.**

6 **“(2) A tax-exempt nonprofit organization may supply to the Oregon**
7 **Liquor Control Commission copies of informational materials about**
8 **human trafficking. The organization may not charge the commission**
9 **for the materials. The form of the materials may include, but need**
10 **not be limited to, adhesive stickers. The materials may not include**
11 **information on topics other than human trafficking. The materials**
12 **must be limited in content to objectively verifiable information, except**
13 **that the materials may include logos, symbols, graphics or similar**
14 **devices and may include a cover letter to commission licensees to urge**
15 **the licensees to post the adhesive materials or other materials at the**
16 **licensees’ premises.**

17 **“(3) Except as provided in this subsection, if a tax-exempt nonprofit**
18 **organization supplies the commission with informational materials as**
19 **described in subsection (2) of this section, the commission shall in-**
20 **clude a copy of the materials with each license renewal notice that the**
21 **commission sends to an on-premises sales, off-premises sales or**
22 **brewery-public house licensee. The number of copies of the materials**

1 that the commission sends to licensees may not exceed the number
2 of copies that the organization supplies to the commission. If the
3 commission determines that the informational materials have offen-
4 sive or inappropriate content, the commission may refuse to include
5 the materials with license renewal notices or otherwise assist in dis-
6 tributing the materials.

7 **“SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2015 Act applies to license renewal
8 notices that the Oregon Liquor Control Commission sends to licensees
9 on or after the effective date of this 2015 Act.**

10 **“SECTION 3. Section 1 of this 2015 Act is repealed on January 2,
11 2018.**

12 **“SECTION 4. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate
13 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
14 declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**
