- ² "SECTION 2. (1) A rural port may construct, purchase, acquire,
- develop, finance, lease, license, handle, provide, add to, contract for,
- interconnect, alter, improve, repair, operate and maintain any tele-
- 5 communications facilities within or without the port's limits:
- 6 "(a) For the port's own use; or
- 7 "(b) For the provision of wholesale telecommunications services 8 within the port's limits.
 - "(2) This section does not authorize a rural port to provide telecommunications services to end users.
 - "(3) A rural port may not exercise powers of eminent domain to acquire telecommunications infrastructure or facilities or contractual rights to telecommunications infrastructure or facilities held by any other person or entity.
 - "(4) As used in this section, 'rural port' means a port that has a population of less than 750,000 within its territorial boundaries.".
