

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2687**

1 Delete lines 5 through 14 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1.** ORS 811.200 is amended to read:

3 “811.200. (1) A person commits the offense of carrying a dog on the ex-
4 ternal part of a vehicle if the person carries a dog upon the hood, fender,
5 running board, **truck bed** or other external part of any automobile or truck
6 that is upon a highway unless the dog is [*protected by framework, carrier or*
7 *other device sufficient to keep it from falling from the vehicle.*] **in an enclosed**
8 **space or, if the space is not enclosed, the dog is otherwise protected**
9 **in a manner that will prevent the dog from being thrown, falling or**
10 **jumping from the vehicle, including but not limited to the following:**

11 **“(a) Securing the dog in a truck bed with walls that are at least 46**
12 **inches in height;**

13 **“(b) Cross tethering the dog to the vehicle; or**

14 **“(c) Placing the dog in a container or cage that is secured to the**
15 **vehicle.**

16 **“(2) A person does not commit the offense of carrying a dog on the**
17 **external part of a vehicle if, at the time the conduct occurs, the person**
18 **is:**

19 **“(a) Operating a farm vehicle registered under ORS 805.300; or**

20 **“(b) Engaged in commercial agriculture.**

21 **“[(2)] (3) The offense described in this section, carrying a dog on the ex-**
22 **ternal part of a vehicle, is a Class D traffic violation.”.**
