

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3315**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 29 and delete page
2 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. (1) Subject to rules prescribed by the State Fish and**
4 **Wildlife Commission, in rendering recompensable assistance to the**
5 **respective officers, departments, boards and commissions of the exec-**
6 **utive department, as defined in ORS 174.112, the State Department of**
7 **Fish and Wildlife shall:**

8 **“(a) For fiscal years beginning on or after July 1, 2015, and before**
9 **July 1, 2019, track and prepare statements reporting the number of**
10 **hours spent by department personnel performing recompensable as-**
11 **sistance for any executive department agency or other entity described**
12 **in this subsection, including an hourly rate that would be charged,**
13 **based on the class of department personnel performing the services.**
14 **The department shall send statements to the agency receiving ser-**
15 **vices, but may not charge for services. This paragraph does not pro-**
16 **hibit the department from charging another state agency for services**
17 **pursuant to an interagency agreement that is in effect between the**
18 **department and the other agency at any time during the period be-**
19 **ginning July 1, 2015, and ending July 1, 2021.**

20 **“(b) For fiscal years beginning on or after July 1, 2019, track and**
21 **prepare statements reporting the number of hours spent by depart-**
22 **ment personnel performing recompensable assistance for any execu-**

1 tive department agency or other entity described in this subsection,
2 including an hourly rate that would be charged, based on the class of
3 department personnel performing the services.

4 “(2) The charges for which statements are prepared and, after July
5 1, 2019, billed include, but are not limited to, costs of providing pro-
6 fessional, investigatory, administrative and clerical services and capi-
7 tal outlay.

8 “(3) For purposes of this section, ‘recompensable assistance’ is as-
9 sistance rendered by the department that relates to fee-funded pro-
10 grams the department is charged with administering.

11 **“SECTION 2.** The State Department of Fish and Wildlife shall esti-
12 mate in advance the expenses that the department will incur during
13 a biennium under section 1 of this 2015 Act, and shall render to exec-
14 utive department agencies and other entities described in section 1 of
15 this 2015 Act an invoice for their share of such expenses for periods
16 within the biennium and in sufficient amounts to provide reasonable
17 cash operating requirements for the department within the biennial
18 period. Each agency or other entity described in section 1 of this 2015
19 Act shall pay to the credit of the department such invoice as an ad-
20 ministrative expense from funds or appropriations available to the in-
21 voiced agency or entity in the same manner as other claims against
22 the state are paid. If the estimated expenses for the agency or other
23 entity described in section 1 of this 2015 Act are more or less than
24 actual expenses for the period covered by the invoice, the difference
25 shall be reflected in the next following estimate of expenses.

26 **“SECTION 3.** (1) Section 1 of this 2015 Act becomes operative on
27 January 1, 2016.

28 “(2) Section 2 of this 2015 Act becomes operative on July 1, 2019.

29 **“SECTION 4.** The State Fish and Wildlife Commission shall adopt
30 rules to implement the provisions of sections 2 and 3 of this 2015 Act

1 on or before January 1, 2016, and may modify those rules at any time
2 thereafter.

3 **“SECTION 5. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate**
4 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**
5 **declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**

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
