

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3362**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, after line 28, insert:

2 “(4) Oregon State University, in consultation with the State Department
3 of Agriculture, shall develop a pesticide use safety plan to educate the public
4 regarding best practices in the use of pesticides. The plan shall include:

5 “(a) Educational materials that are appropriate and effective for a broad
6 audience, including, but not limited to, pesticide applicators, consultants,
7 dealers, operators and trainees and private applicators, as those terms are
8 defined in ORS 634.006, and members of the public; and

9 “(b) A communication strategy for dissemination of educational materials
10 using media sources, state agencies, associations and organizations.”.

11 On page 2, line 4, delete “locations of such”.

12 In line 5, delete “colonies and the name,”.

13 In line 26, delete “honeybee and native” and insert “pollinator research
14 that is predominantly focused on honeybees.”.

15 Delete line 27.

16 In line 44, after “(5)” insert “(a)”.

17 On page 3, line 1, delete the boldfaced material and restore the bracketed
18 material.

19 Delete lines 42 through 44 and insert:

20 “(4) The department shall apply \$10 of each registration fee collected
21 pursuant to ORS 634.016 to fulfill the provisions of section 1 (2), chapter 40,
22 Oregon Laws 2014.

1 **“SECTION 6.** ORS 634.326, as amended by section 5 of this 2015 Act, is
2 amended to read:

3 “634.326. (1) The State Department of Agriculture shall deposit all fees
4 paid to it under the provisions of this chapter in the Department of Agri-
5 culture Service Fund. Such moneys are continuously appropriated to the de-
6 partment for the purpose of administering and enforcing the provisions of
7 this chapter.

8 “(2) An amount of the fees and moneys referred to in subsection (1) of this
9 section not to exceed 10 percent of registration fees received under ORS
10 634.016 may be used by the department pursuant to agreements entered into
11 between the department and the Dean of the College of Agricultural Sciences
12 of Oregon State University, with the advice of the Minor Crops Advisory
13 Committee for the purposes set forth in subsection (3) of this section.

14 “(3) The amounts provided for in subsection (2) of this section shall be
15 used by the Dean of the College of Agricultural Sciences of Oregon State
16 University for research projects and investigations agreed upon by the dean
17 and the department directed toward obtaining pesticide use registrations
18 needed by growers to produce crops economically in Oregon.

19 “(4) The department shall apply \$10 of each registration fee collected
20 pursuant to ORS 634.016 to fulfill the provisions of section 1 [(2)] (4), chapter
21 40, Oregon Laws 2014.

22 **“SECTION 7. (1) The amendments to ORS 634.326 by section 5 of this**
23 **2015 Act apply to registration fees due under ORS 634.016 on or after**
24 **the effective date of this 2015 Act and before January 1, 2019.**

25 **“(2) The amendments to ORS 634.326 by section 6 of this 2015 Act**
26 **apply to registration fees due under ORS 634.016 on or after January**
27 **1, 2019.”.**

28 In line 45, delete “6” and insert “8”.

29 On page 4, after line 2, insert:

30 “(2) The amendments to ORS 634.326 by section 6 of this 2015 Act become

1 operative on January 1, 2019.”.

2 In line 3, delete “(2)” and insert “(3)”.

3 In line 9, delete “7” and insert “9”.

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
