

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 808**

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, before the period insert “; and declaring an  
2 emergency”.

3 Delete lines 5 through 18 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 2. (1) The Task Force on Mass Care and Sheltering in**  
5 **Support of Cascadia Planning Efforts is established, consisting of 21**  
6 **members appointed as follows:**

7 **“(a) The President of the Senate shall appoint one member from**  
8 **among members of the Senate.**

9 **“(b) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint one**  
10 **member from among members of the House of Representatives.**

11 **“(c) The Governor shall appoint 13 representatives as follows:**

12 **“(A) One member to represent human services.**

13 **“(B) One member to represent health services.**

14 **“(C) One member to represent housing services.**

15 **“(D) One member as recommended by the Association of Oregon**  
16 **Counties.**

17 **“(E) One member as recommended by the League of Oregon Cities.**

18 **“(F) One member to represent private large retail businesses.**

19 **“(G) One member to represent the American Red Cross.**

20 **“(H) One member to represent local emergency management enti-**  
21 **ties from west of the Cascade Mountain Range.**

22 **“(I) One member to represent local emergency management entities**

1 from east of the Cascade Mountain Range.

2 “(J) One member to represent the Oregon Association of Hospitals  
3 and Health Systems.

4 “(K) One member to represent Oregon Voluntary Organizations  
5 Active in Disasters.

6 “(L) One member to represent the Oregon Food Bank.

7 “(M) One member to represent Tribal Nations.

8 “(d) The chair of the Seismic Safety Policy Advisory Commission,  
9 or a member of the Seismic Safety Policy Advisory Commissions des-  
10 ignated by the chair.

11 “(e) The Director of Human Services, or another officer or employee  
12 of the Department of Human Services as designated by the director.

13 “(f) The Director of the Housing and Community Services Depart-  
14 ment, or another officer or employee of the Housing and Community  
15 Services Department as designated by the director.

16 “(g) The Director of Agriculture, or another officer or employee of  
17 the State Department of Agriculture as designated by the director.

18 “(h) The Public Health Director appointed by the Director of the  
19 Oregon Health Authority under ORS 431.035, or another officer or  
20 employee of the Oregon Health Authority as designated by the Public  
21 Health Director.

22 “(i) The Director of the Office of Emergency Management, or an-  
23 other officer or employee of the Office of Emergency Management as  
24 designated by the director.

25 “(2) The task force shall facilitate a review of established state and  
26 local plans in relation to mass care, housing and emergency assistance  
27 necessary in the event of naturally occurring seismic events associated  
28 with geologic shifts along the Cascadia subduction zone.

29 “(3) The task force may make recommendations related to state and  
30 local capacities to provide:

1       **“(a) Temporary shelter and permanent and semipermanent housing;**

2       **“(b) Emergency food and water supplies;**

3       **“(c) Emergency health care services;**

4       **“(d) Transitional services and assistance with recovery; and**

5       **“(e) Sheltering and care of animals in support of mass care.**

6       **“(4) A majority of the voting members of the task force constitutes**  
7 **a quorum for the transaction of business.**

8       **“(5) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a**  
9 **majority of the voting members of the task force.**

10       **“(6) The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as**  
11 **chairperson.**

12       **“(7) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the appointing authority**  
13 **shall make an appointment to become immediately effective.**

14       **“(8) The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the**  
15 **call of the chairperson or of a majority of the voting members of the**  
16 **task force.**

17       **“(9) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation of**  
18 **the task force.**

19       **“(10) The task force shall submit a report in the manner provided**  
20 **by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to**  
21 **an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to human**  
22 **services as appropriate no later than September 15, 2017.**

23       **“(11) The Department of Human Services shall provide staff support**  
24 **to the task force.**

25       **“(12) Members of the task force who are not members of the Leg-**  
26 **islative Assembly are not entitled to compensation, but may be reim-**  
27 **bursed for actual and necessary travel and other expenses incurred by**  
28 **them in the performance of their official duties in the manner and**  
29 **amounts provided for in ORS 292.495. Claims for expenses incurred in**  
30 **performing functions of the task force shall be paid out of funds ap-**

1 **propriated to the Department of Human Services for purposes of the**  
2 **task force.**

3 **“(13) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111,**  
4 **are directed to assist the task force in the performance of its duties**  
5 **and, to the extent permitted by laws relating to confidentiality, to**  
6 **furnish such information and advice as the members of the task force**  
7 **consider necessary to perform their duties.**

8 **“SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is repealed December 31,**  
9 **2018.**

10 **“SECTION 4. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate**  
11 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**  
12 **declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**
