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- 9 "SECTION 10. Section 9 of this 2015 Act is amended to read:
- "Sec. 9. (1) The [Oregon Education Investment Board] State Board of 10 Education shall identify model programs and best practices for a school 11 district to implement to encourage the students of the school district to 12 participate in an accelerated college credit program and enroll in a post-13 secondary institution of education. The board may identify programs and 14 practices tailored for students with specific backgrounds or characteristics 15 and shall identify practices that standardize transcripts to the extent that 16 students may more easily transition to an accelerated college credit program 17 from other accelerated programs in a school district. 18
 - "(2) Each school district shall annually inform the parents of its students in grades 9 through 12 of the availability and transferability of accelerated college credit program credits, including the student eligibility requirements and the financial and academic benefits of earning college credit while in

1 high school.".
