

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 2890**

1 Delete lines 4 through 12 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part**  
3 **of ORS chapter 419B.**

4 **“SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section:**

5 **“(a) ‘Extracurricular activities’ means age-appropriate or develop-**  
6 **mentally appropriate activities as follows:**

7 **“(A) Activities or items that are generally accepted as suitable for**  
8 **children or wards of the same chronological age or level of maturity**  
9 **or that are determined to be developmentally appropriate for a child**  
10 **or ward, based on the development of cognitive, emotional, physical**  
11 **and behavioral capacities that are typical for an age or age group; and**

12 **“(B) In the case of a specific child or ward, activities or items that**  
13 **are suitable for the child or ward based on the developmental stages**  
14 **attained by the child or ward with respect to the cognitive, emotional,**  
15 **physical and behavioral capacities of the child or ward.**

16 **“(b) ‘Reasonable and prudent parent standard’ means the standard,**  
17 **characterized by careful and sensible parental decisions that maintain**  
18 **the health, safety and best interests of a child or ward while encour-**  
19 **aging the emotional and developmental growth of the child or ward,**  
20 **that a substitute care provider shall use when determining whether**  
21 **to allow a child or ward in substitute care to participate in extracur-**  
22 **ricular activities.**

1       **“(2) The Department of Human Services shall, in accordance with**  
2 **rules adopted by the department, ensure that a substitute care pro-**  
3 **vider for a child or ward in the care or custody of the department**  
4 **provides an opportunity for the child or ward to participate in at least**  
5 **one extracurricular activity and applies a reasonable and prudent**  
6 **parent standard when determining such participation. The department**  
7 **and substitute care provider shall confer to determine the party that**  
8 **will be responsible for payment of any fee or charge related to a child’s**  
9 **or ward’s participation in an extracurricular activity as required by**  
10 **this section.”.**
