

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 561**

1 After line 2 of the printed bill, insert:

2 “Whereas communities and local entities can benefit from the support of  
3 the Oregon Health Authority following a suicide; and

4 Whereas this legislation is designed to ensure that expertise in suicide  
5 prevention, intervention and post-intervention is readily available in a timely  
6 manner; now, therefore,”.

7 Delete lines 4 through 16 and insert:

8 **“SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, ‘local mental health au-**  
9 **thority’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 430.630.**

10 **“(2) The Oregon Health Authority shall develop a plan for commu-**  
11 **nication among local mental health authorities and local systems to**  
12 **improve notifications and information-sharing when a death that is**  
13 **suspected to be a suicide involves an individual who is 24 years of age**  
14 **or younger. The plan must address community suicide response and**  
15 **post-intervention efforts to address loss and the potential of contagion**  
16 **risk. The following entities may be involved in developing and imple-**  
17 **menting the plan:**

18 **“(a) Public school districts;**

19 **“(b) Public universities listed in ORS 352.002, if the death involves**  
20 **an individual who is 24 years of age or younger;**

21 **“(c) Private post-secondary institutions of education, if the death**  
22 **involves an individual who is 24 years of age or younger; and**

1       “(d) Any facility that provides services or resources to runaway or  
2 homeless youth.

3       “(3) Within seven days after a death that is suspected to be a sui-  
4 cide of an individual 24 years of age or younger, the local mental  
5 health authority in the area where the suicide occurred shall inform  
6 the Oregon Health Authority, in a manner and in a format to be de-  
7 termined by the authority, of activities implemented to support local  
8 entities and individuals affected by the suicide and to prevent the risk  
9 of contagion. The authority shall serve as a resource to the local  
10 mental health authority as needed by the community.”.

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
