

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2996**

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, after line 9, insert:

2 “(6) In order to ensure that the center is effectively performing its duties
3 under this section, the center shall track key performance indicators and
4 report annually on the status of these performance indicators to the De-
5 partment of Consumer and Business Services. The performance indicators
6 tracked by the center and reported to the department must include, but are
7 not limited to:

8 “(a) The improvement in workforce development, as measured by the in-
9 creased number of students enrolled in cyber-related programs annually;

10 “(b) The success of the center in identifying critical post-graduate or
11 post-secondary cyber-credentials, as determined each biennium by:

12 “(A) The number of new and existing continuing education and workforce
13 training hours offered; and

14 “(B) The number of workers trained by affiliate programs;

15 “(c) The annual amount of independent support funds raised for research
16 and fees for services in support of the center;

17 “(d) Community involvement and the number of independent businesses
18 involved with educational and response activity through the center on an
19 annual basis;

20 “(e) The number of businesses that create business continuity plans or
21 that use the center’s cyber-security tools annually; and

22 “(f) The ability of the center to develop methods to track potential risk

1 and the resulting amount of money saved by Oregon businesses annually.”.

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
