

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 950**

1 After line 2 of the printed bill, insert:

2 “Whereas leading programs in architecture, wood science and engineering  
3 at the University of Oregon and Oregon State University are collaborating  
4 to partner with building design professionals and wood products manufac-  
5 turers to drive innovation and testing for new engineered wood materials at  
6 the Center for Advanced Wood Products Manufacturing and Design; and

7 “Whereas the research, product testing and educational programs con-  
8 ducted by the universities at the center will foster innovative design of  
9 sustainable buildings and directly support growth of manufacturing jobs in  
10 rural communities of this state where the timber industry is positioned to  
11 capitalize on the growing demand for new products in domestic and global  
12 markets; now, therefore,”.

13 Delete lines 4 through 8 and insert:

14 **“SECTION 1. There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1,**  
15 **2015, from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund,**  
16 **to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, the amount of**  
17 **\$3,400,000 for use by the College of Forestry at Oregon State Univer-**  
18 **sity, in cooperation with the University of Oregon, to operate a center**  
19 **for the manufacturing and design of advanced wood products.”.**
