PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2050

- Delete lines 5 through 15 of the printed bill and insert:
- ² "SECTION 1. (1) In order to provide for the protection of human
- 3 safety by reducing human interactions with cougars, the State De-
- 4 partment of Fish and Wildlife shall develop by rule a program to allow
- 5 for the use of one or more dogs to hunt or pursue cougars in certain
- 6 targeted controlled hunt areas. The program:
- 7 "(a) Must be based on the best available science and data related
- 8 to cougar populations; and
- 9 "(b) May only be implemented within a targeted controlled hunt
- 10 area identified by the department if a county measure is approved
- under subsection (2) of this section that allows for the program to be
- implemented in the county where the targeted controlled hunt area is

- "(2)(a) A targeted controlled hunt area for cougars in a county is
- exempt from the applicability of the provisions of ORS 498.164 related
- 16 to cougars if a county measure is approved that:
- 17 "(A) Approves the implementation of the program developed under
- subsection (1) of this section within the targeted controlled hunt areas
- identified by the department and located in the county; and
- 20 "(B) Exempts targeted controlled hunt areas in the county from the
- 21 applicability of the provisions of ORS 498.164 related to cougars.
 - "(b) A measure under this subsection may be proposed by initiative

petition, or referred to the people by the governing body of the county, to be voted on at an election held on a date specified in ORS 203.085 (1).

"(3) A county with a targeted controlled hunt area in the county that is exempt from the applicability of the provisions of ORS 498.164 related to cougars pursuant to subsection (2) of this section shall notify the department. Upon notification from the county, the department shall implement the program developed under subsection (1) of this section.

"(4) The approval of a county measure by a county under this section does not affect the authority of the State Fish and Wildlife Commission to manage cougars in the county under any other provision of the wildlife laws.".
